DECEMBER 6TH - YOUTH 4 SAFETY INVITE YOU TO A VIGIL TO HONOUR THE 14 MURDERED WOMEN IN MONTREAL AND THE THOUSANDS OF MISSING AND MURDERED ABORIGINAL WOMEN.

December 6th is the National Day of Remembrance and Action on Violence Against Women in Canada, this day is also known as White Ribbon Day. Established in 1991 by the parliament of Canada, this day marks the anniversary of the murders in 1989 of 14 young women at l'école polytechnique de Montréal. They died because they were women. It is also a day where we take time to remember and honor our Missing and Murdered Aboriginal Women.

We will be commemorating the 14 young women whose lives ended in an act of gender-based violence that shocked the nation, December 6th represents an opportunity for Canadians to reflect on the epidemic of violence against women in our community. It is also an opportunity to consider the women and girls for whom violence is a daily reality, and to remember those who have died as a result of violence. and finally, it is a day on which communities can consider concrete actions to eliminate all forms of violence against women and girls.

This year our youth for safety participants at the WLSS will be paying tribute to the 14 murdered women and our Murdered and Missing Aboriginal Women.

We would encourage everyone to attend this very important event that touches all of our lives.

Holiday Baking Recipe

Cranberry Eggnog Muffins

Ingredients

- 2 cups all-purpose flour
- 3/4 cup sugar
- 3 teaspoons baking powder
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/4 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- 1 large egg
- 1 cup eggnog
- 1/4 cup butter, melted
- 3/4 cup whole-berry cranberry sauce



Directions

1. Preheat oven to 400°. In a large bowl, whisk the first five ingredients. In another bowl, whisk egg, eggnog and melted butter until blended. Add to flour mixture; stir just until moistened.
2. Spoon 1 tablespoon batter in bottom of each of 12 greased or paper-lined muffin cups. Drop 1 teaspoon cranberry sauce into center of each; top with remaining batter and cranberry sauce. Cut through batter with a knife to swirl.
3. Bake 15-18 minutes or until a toothpick inserted in center comes out clean. Cool 5 minutes before removing from pan to a wire rack. Serve warm. Yield: 1 dozen.
