A quorum is all members of the Kaska National Council (31) and:

(15 citizens from 3 communities + 31 National Council members = **44** Kaska present)
- B. at least at least five (5) members of each of the five (5) Kaska First Nations?
(25 citizens from 5 communities + 31 National Council members = **56** Kaska present)
- C. at least three (3) members of at least three (3) of the five Kaska First Nations?
(9 citizens from 3 communities is the current quorum rule = **9** Kaska present)
